FIGURE DRAWING

Please find below a list of recommended materials for the course throughout the year. Any student wishing to discuss materials with their lecturer can wait to purchase these from the Gray's Art Material Shop at the start of the course. **Please note:** for the first class students are required to bring the following:

A basic roll of lining paper, pure graphite pencil, charcoal, putty rubber and masking tape.

Initial classes thereafter require a sketchbook, cartridge paper, pencils, putty rubber, sharpener & masking tape. Students will then be introduced to some alternative drawing materials. Please review your complete materials list below:

Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Roll of lining paper - available from B&Q or use the back of an old roll of wallpaper.• A2 pad, A1 sheets of good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier).• Several sheets of Ingres paper or sugar paper A2.• Sheet of watercolour paper 50 x 70cm (optional).• Sheet of blotting paper A2 (optional).• Sheet of Satimat paper A2 or A1.• Sketchbook A4 or A3 (ring bound).
Pencils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A range of good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B, 4B.• A pure graphite pencil (this has no barrel).• Conté crayon or wax pencils (white, sanguine, sepia or black).
Drawing Pens	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fine tip (black or brown) water-soluble (non-permanent/not waterproof) and permanent pen.
Charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Willow Charcoal. Assorted pack.
Pastel	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chalk or oil.
Fixative	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive) or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.
Indian Ink	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 14ml pot (black).
Brushes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A small selection of watercolour brushes.
Essentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masking tape, putty rubber and sharpener.

Drawing boards will be supplied by the art school.
