For the first class students are required to bring the following:

A sketchbook, cartridge paper, pencil, putty rubber and masking tape.

Please note: any course materials provided are for small scale test and development work only. Any student wishing to develop large or extensive work must seek prior approval from the course tutor and appropriate technician. This will incur an additional cost for materials. Paper etc	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A1 good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier). 25 sheets.• A range of textured / sized papers e.g. (coloured paper, black and assorted mid toned sugar papers, tissue papers, cardboard).• Roll of lining paper.• A3 Acetate x 2.• Sketchbook A6 or A4 (ring bound). OPTIONAL A3 or A5 recommended.
Pencils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A range of good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B, 4B.• A pure graphite pencil (this has no barrel) or graphite stick.
Conté	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conté crayon or Conté pencils. Black, white, sanguine and sepia.
Charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assorted pack.
Ink	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 30ml pot black indian ink.• Permanent drawing pen• Water Soluble drawing pen.
Pastel	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good quality chalk pastel or oil pastel pack.
Fixative	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive) or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.
Paint	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gouache starter set.
