

Cost of Accommodation

Prices range from £98 to £166 per week and depend on the location and type of room, for example single with or without an en suite bathroom. The rent prices are fully inclusive of Wi Fi and internet access, utilities (electricity, heating and hot water), personal contents insurance and weekly cleaning of communal areas.
