RGU:Union

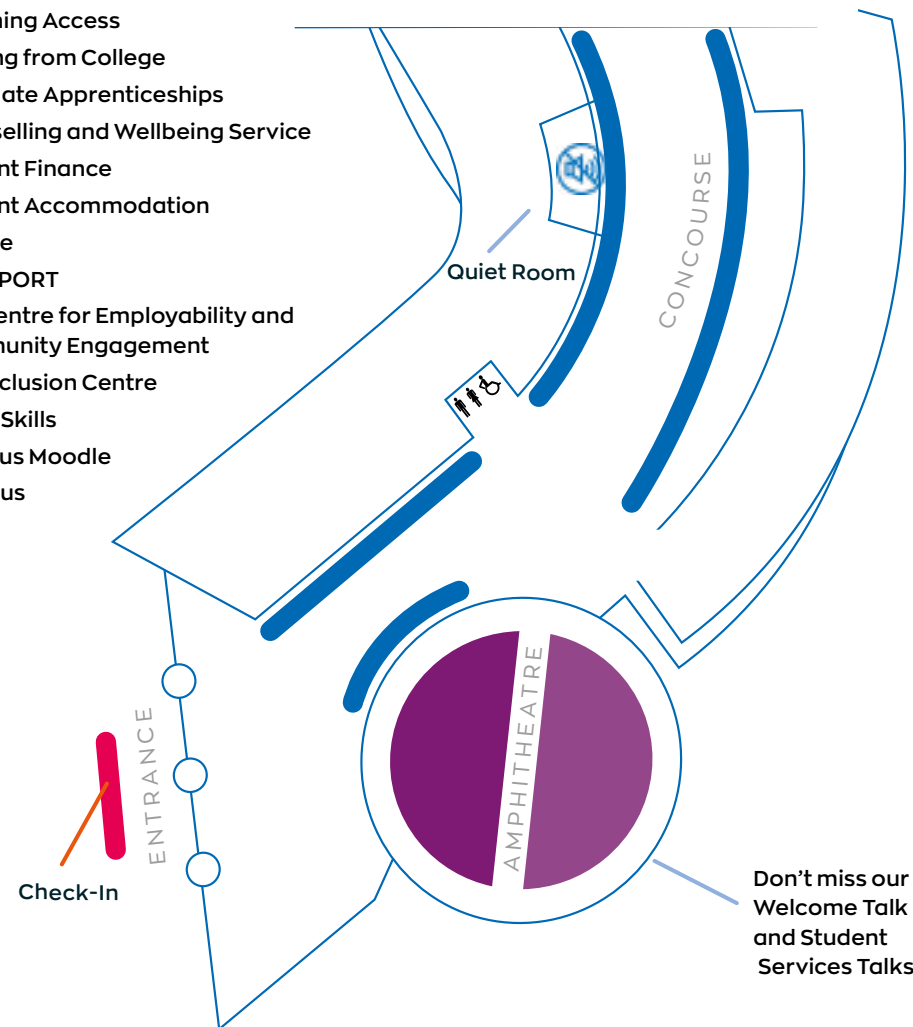

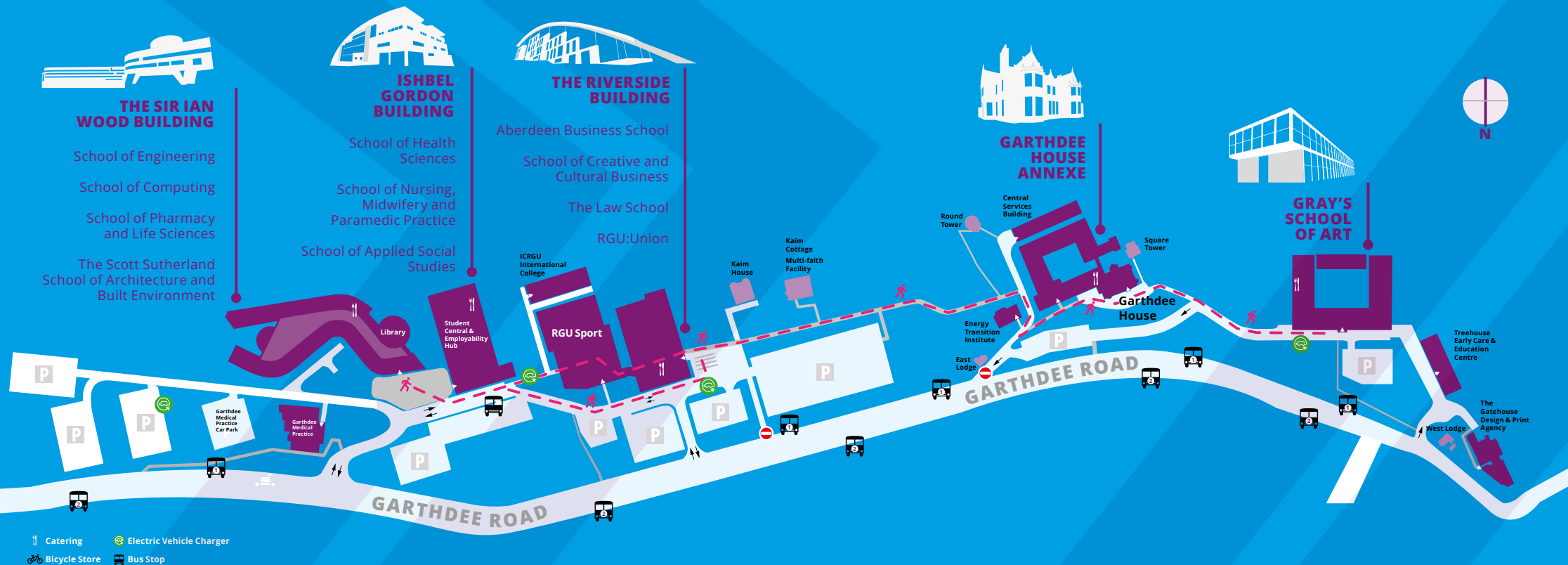

What you need to know on the day

Getting here

There are ample car parking spaces available on campus and except for spaces outside of RGU SPORT, parking restrictions are not enforced on Discovery Day.

There are a limited number of electric vehicle charge points on campus (see Page 5 campus map locations). Plug in your vehicle, scan the machine's QR code and select the payment card, or Google/Apple Pay, which will pre-authorise £15 (approximate cost of 4 hour charge). Please note, vehicles are not permitted to exceed 4 hours of charging.

Alternatively, First Bus Aberdeen services 1 & 2 operate between the city centre and our campus on a regular basis.

Fire safety

In the event of a fire alarm sounding, please proceed to the nearest fire exit and comply with any reasonable requests by RGU staff/fire stewards. If you discover a fire, please raise the alarm and call 999.

WiFi

'The Cloud' WiFi service is available across campus and offers free internet access for 3 hours total per day per device.
