RGU PROVIDED SCHOLARSHIPS

Given to all students from East Africa, these RGU provided scholarships provide a fee reduction of £2000 for Postgraduate courses, and £3000 for the first year of Undergraduate tuition fees. You will be notified of this award in your admission offer letter.

We also have a Vice Chancellor's Scholarship, open to Undergraduate students from East Africa. This is a full fees award for the first year of study.

RGU START UP ACCELERATOR

As the origins of RGU are rooted in innovation, we also offer students multiple opportunities for ideation, startup creation and learning-by-doing in the broad area of entrepreneurship. An example of this is our exciting 'RGU Startup Accelerator' which supports entrepreneurial teams from any subject, at any level, to create new businesses. Up to 30 teams are chosen through a competition process each year, and each team will receive up to £10,000 of funding each as well as 6 months of support, startup space and mentoring.

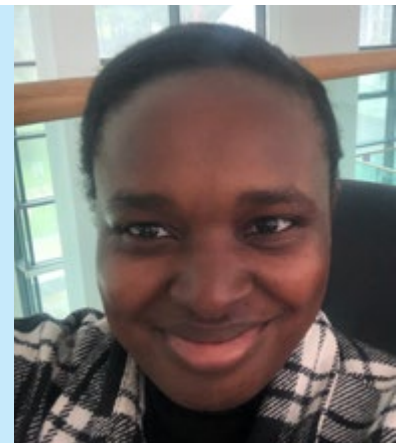
