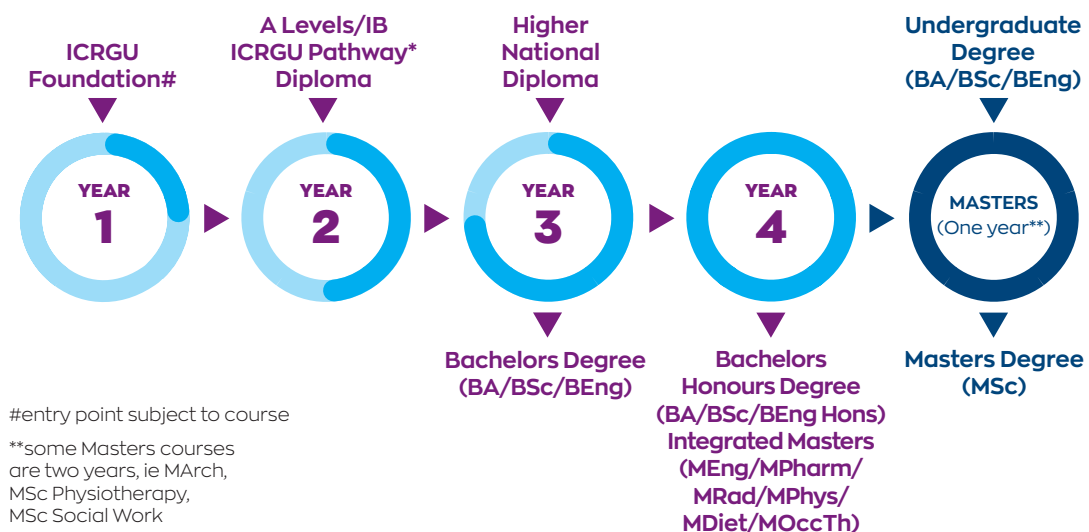

ENTREPREUNERSHIP

As the origins of RGU are rooted in innovation, we also offer students multiple opportunities for ideation, startup creation and learning-by-doing in the broad area of entrepreneurship. An example of this is our exciting 'RGU Startup Accelerator' which supports entrepreneurial teams from any subject, at any level, to create new businesses. Sixteen teams are chosen through a competition process each year, and each team will receive up to £1,000 of seed funding as well as a 6 month training and mentoring programme to support them in creating their new businesses. They then have the opportunity to pitch for prizes worth around £15k.

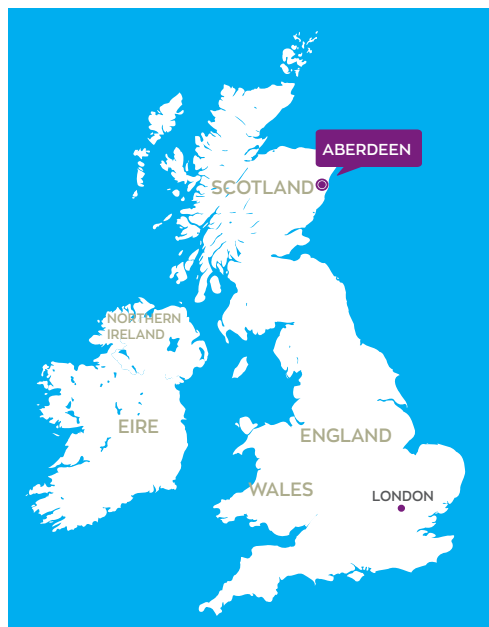
