APPLICATION AND COMPOSITION

Please find below a list of recommended materials for the course throughout the year. Any student wishing to discuss materials with their lecturer can wait to purchase these from the Gray's Art Material Shop at the start of the course. **Please note:** for the first class students are required to bring the following:

A basic roll of lining paper, charcoal, coloured pencil, coloured chalk pastels and masking tape.

Initial classes thereafter require a sketchbook, cartridge paper, pencils, putty rubber, sharpener & masking tape. Students will then be introduced to some alternative drawing materials. Please review your complete materials list below:

Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Roll of lining paper - available from B&Q or use the back of an old roll of wallpaper.• Selection of good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier) A2 and A1.• A range of different papers A2 - A1 coloured/assorted deep toned papers. ingres, sugar paper, etc.• Sketchbook A4 (ring bound).
Pencils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A range of good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B, 4B.• Coloured pencils (full colour set).
Drawing Pens	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fine tip (black) water-soluble and permanent pen.
Charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Willow charcoal. Assorted pack.
Pastel	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chalk and/or Conté crayon (full colour set).• Oil pastel (full colour set).
Fixative	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive) or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.
Water-based Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gouache paint and/or watercolour and drawing ink (full colour set).
Brushes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Small & medium watercolour brushes.
Essentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masking tape, putty rubber and sharpener.

Drawing boards will be supplied by the art school.
