

GROUND SHED AND ASSOCIATED BUILDINGS

ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY A PERSON DISCOVERING A FIRE

- Alert occupants of buildings by shouting FIRE
- Dial 999 to call the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service
- If possible tackle the fire using the appliances provided (DO NOT endanger yourself or others in doing so)

ACTION TO BE TAKEN ON HEARING THE FIRE WARNING

- Leave the building by the nearest safest available exit/route (closing all doors and windows behind you, whenever possible to do so safely)
- Follow the  signs
- Report to responsible person in charge of the appropriate assembly point
- DO NOT take risks

FIRE EXIT

The exit routes from the buildings are detailed below, please ensure that all persons utilise the nearest safest exit.
