Students are required to bring a basic notebook or sketchbook (A4 or A5) to classes in order to record ideas and thoughts. It would be advantageous to document progress with a digital camera or smartphone.

Paper • Sketchbook A4 (ring bound).

Tracing paper 2 X A4 sheets.

Pencils • Good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B.

Essentials • 2 x AA batteries.

• Saw blades 2/0 x 24 (two bundles of 12).

2 x Wet and dry sandpaper (240 grade).

• 2 x Wet and dry sandpaper (600 grade).

Recommended • Piercing saw.

• Steel Construction Divider Caliper.

Steel ruler.

Wax heat pen.
