Please find below a list of recommended materials for the course throughout the year. Any student wishing to discuss materials with their lecturer can wait to purchase these from the Gray's Art Material Shop at the start of the course. **Please note:** for the first class students are required to bring the following:

A basic roll of lining paper, charcoal, putty rubber and masking tape.

Initial classes thereafter require a sketchbook, cartridge paper, pencils, putty rubber, sharpener 8 masking tape. Students will then be introduced to some alternative drawing materials. Please review your complete materials list below:

Fixative	 You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive) or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.

Water-based	Gouache paint and/or drawing ink.

Brushes	Small 8 medium watercolour brushes.
Essentials	 Masking tape, putty rubber and sharpener.
