Please find below a list of recommended materials for the course throughout the year. Any student wishing to discuss materials with their lecturer can wait to purchase these from the Gray's Art Material Shop at the start of the course.

For the first class students are required to bring the following:

A sketchbook, cartridge paper, pencil, putty rubber and masking tape.

Please note: any course materials provided are for small scale test and development work only. Any student wishing to develop large or extensive work must seek prior approval from the course tutor and appropriate technician. This will incur an additional cost for materials. Please review your portfolio materials list below:

Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A2 pad of good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier).• A range of textured / sized papers e.g. (coloured paper, black and assorted mid toned papers, tissue papers, cardboard).• Sketchbook A5 or A4 (ring bound).
Pencils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A range of good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B, 4B.• A pure graphite pencil (this has no barrel).
Conté	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conté crayon or Conté pencils.
Charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assorted pack.
Pastel	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chalk or oil.
Fixative	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive) or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.
Paint	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gouache.
Brushes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A range of fine painting to large household brushes.
Essentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masking tape, putty rubber and sharpener, craft knife, scissors, PVA glue.

Drawing boards will be supplied by the art school.
