Please find below a list of recommended materials for the course throughout the year. Students may wish to wait to purchase and discuss materials with their lecturer during induction some materials as a group order with their lecturer.

Students are required to bring a basic notebook or sketchbook to classes in order to record ideas and thoughts. It would be advantageous to document progress with a digital camera or smartphone.

It is recommended for students to bring several sheets of cartridge paper and drawing tools for the initial classes.

Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier).• Different types of paper (optional).• Notebook A4 or A5.• Sketchbook A5 or A4 (ring bound).
Drawing Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good quality pencils, e.g. HB, 2B• Permanent marker pen.• Putty rubber.• Sharpener.• Coloured pencils or crayons.• Gouache paint and brushes.
Tapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masking tape ($\frac{3}{4}$" or 1" wide).• Brown parcel tape.• Cellotape.
Cutting Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fabric scissors.• Paper scissors.• Craft knife (retractable blade).
Measuring Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clear plastic ruler.• Measuring tape (combined metric + imperial).
Essentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plastic tubs/jars with lids (to keep paint/dyes-to be airtight).• Apron.• Wooden/plastic spoons for mixing colours.• Small Metal headed pins,
