

## SHORT COURSE PROVISION MATERIALS LIST

ADVANCED FIGURATIVE STUDY

As your course consists of self-directed study your materials list is of your own choice. Advice on materials will be tailored to your individual chosen path of creative development and will initially be explored on induction in the first week. Please find below a list of optional material to get you thinking. Please note: this list is by no means a requirement (although sketchbooks are especially encouraged), it just offers some ideas. Materials can be purchased from the Gray's Art Material Shop at a discounted cost when showing your student ID card. Any student wishing to discuss materials with their lecturer will be very welcome to do so at the beginning of the course. For the first class students may wish to bring the following:

Paper (numerous sheets or a roll), drawing medium of choice and masking tape.

Perhaps you might consider prepping the surface with paint or different paper surfaces. Initial classes thereafter are self-directed but do bring a sketchbook. Please review some basic possibilities below:

Paper

- A1 good quality cartridge paper (130 mg or heavier).
- Ingres paper.
- Sugar paper.
- Satimat paper.
- Kraft paper.
- Watercolour paper.
- Sketchbook A4 or A3 (ring bound).

Pencils

- A range of good quality soft pencils, e.g. HB, 2B, 4B.
- A pure graphite pencil (this has no barrel).
- Conté crayon or wax pencils (white, sanguine, sepia or black).

**Drawing Pens** 

Fine tip (black or brown) water-soluble and permanent pen.

Charcoal

Willow charcoal. Assorted pack.

Pastel

Chalk or oil.

**Fixative** 

You can purchase 'fixative' to fix a drawing (this can be expensive)
or use an ordinary hairspray which will work just as well.

Indian Ink

14ml pot (black).

Brushes

• A selection of brushes to suit your painting medium.

• Gouache, \*oil or acrylic (don't forget jars and rags if this is your

preference).

Painting support • Primed canvas, board or paper.

Essentials
Masking tape, putty rubber and sharpener.

\*Should the use of solvents be required for oil painting we request that you please use a low odour option such as Zest-it or Sansodor.

Drawing boards will be supplied by the art school.
